State does not impose a state sales or use tax

Must conduct solicitation in state AND exceed economic sales/transaction threshold to establish sales tax nexus

Colorado also has a customer reporting requirement (\$100,000 sales)

Massachusetts' economic nexus is only applicable for "internet vendors" with physical presence (cookies/apps/in-state servers), effective Oct. 1, 2017; \$500,000 sales and 100 transactions

Nebraska published an FAQ stating they will adopt the South Dakota Wayfair economic nexus test, but nothing has changed in its statutes or regulations

Ohio's economic nexus is only applicable to sellers with in-state software, effective Jan. 1, 2018; \$500,000 sales

State provides remote sellers an election; sellers can choose to collect and remit sales tax OR comply with reporting and notification requirements (different in each state)

Washington previously offered election for remote sellers with more than \$10,000 in sales to collect sales tax OR report/notify effective Jan. 1, 2018; effective Oct. 1, 2018, taxpayers no longer have option if they meet economic nexus test (\$100,000 in sales or 200 transactions)
